<p>Day 17</p>	<p>Rotorua City Tour</p> <p>Explore the “Thermal City” of Rotorua. Visit Te Puia Geothermal Reserve to view the boiling mud pools and cascading Pohutu geyser, that makes Rotorua famous. Enjoy Skyline Gondola ride.</p> <p>There is an opportunity to explore other optional attractions available, such as Rainbow Springs, Paradise valley springs etc.</p> <p>Then, an unforgettable 3.5 hour Maori Culture experience & Hangi Dinner! Journey to an authentic Maori village nestled in Rotorua forest and be formally welcomed into the sacred grounds, where amidst crackling village fires you will discover Maori art forms, ancient rituals and Maori traditions.</p> <p>Let us share our thrilling song and dance, and then enjoy a 3 course meal with your Maori hosts.</p> <p><i>Breakfast, Hangi Dinner</i> <i>Overnight in Rotorua</i></p>

<p>Day 18</p>	<p>Arrive Queenstown</p> <p>After Breakfast we arrive to Rotoroa Airport to take the flight to Queenstown (Airfare not included) We reach Queenstown in the afternoon. <p>Day 19</p>	<p>Queenstown City Tour & Gondola</p> <p>Today is free for you to relax and enjoy the endless options available in Queenstown.</p> <p>You may try optional activities like bungy jumping, jet boating, white water rafting, four wheel driving, cruising on lake Wakatipu etc.</p> <p>In the evening riding a gondola to the summit of Bob's peak for panoramic with buffet dinner</p> <p><i>Breakfast, Dinner (Gondola Buffet Dinner)</i> <i>Overnight in Queenstown.</i></p>
<p>Day 20</p>	<p>Arrowtown - Lake Wanak - Fox Glazier</p> <p>Enjoy a visit to Arrowtown, a colourful township steeped in local history. Then it's a trio of lakes – Lake Dunstan, Lake Hawea & Lake Wanaka. Travel through Haast Pass which winds its way through Mount Aspiring National Park and dramatic mountain and forest scenery. Continue north along the coastal road to Fox Glacier – a rare, still advancing glacier. Fox Glacier is the longest of the awe-inspiring New Zealand West Coast glaciers. At its head, soaring peaks of over 3,000m (10,000ft) dominate the vista. These include Aoraki (Mt Cook) and Mt Tasman. This mighty moving river of ice falls 2,600 metres, or a little over 8,000ft, on its journey from the base of the Southern Alps to the West Coast. (optional Fox Glacier scenic flight)</p> <p><i>Breakfast, Dinner</i> <i>Overnight in the Glacier Region.</i></p>

<p>Day 21</p>	<p>Fox Glacier – Greymouth - Christchurch (Optional TranzAlpine Train)</p> <p>Today your day starts early. Travel through Greymouth, the largest town on the West Coast. On the way to Christchurch is a scenic drive in for you as you travel further north, past Hokitika and through the lush green beech forests to the alpine village of Arthur’s Pass before crossing the spectacular Southern Alps. Drive beside the Waimakariri River and across the Canterbury Plains to reach the “Garden City” of Christchurch. Check in at your Hotel and relax for the rest of the evening.</p> <p>TranzAlpine Train Option: Experience one of the world’s top 6 train trips aboard the TranzAlpine to Christchurch. Additional cost \$NZ 149 per person from Greymouth to Christchurch</p> <p><i>Breakfast, Dinner . Overnight in Christchurch</i></p>
<p>Day 22</p>	<p>Christchurch City Tour</p> <p>Exploring Christchurch “The Garden city” which is famous for its gardens and being the most English city outside of England. Visit to One of New Zealand's best tourist attractions, the International Antarctic Centre near Christchurch airport provides visitors of all ages with an interactive, fun and exciting experience of Antarctica.</p> <p><i>Breakfast, Dinner Overnight in Christchurch</i></p>
